SDU Highlights

The City of Salinas has brought back the **FREE** graffiti abatement program. Call 758-7926 and provide the address and a description of where the graffiti is located. The property owner or responsible party will have to sign over permission for the City to paint on their property. This is a completely free service provided to anyone in the City of Salinas.

With the free service there is no excuse to allow graffiti on any property. Allowing graffiti to stay sends a message to the criminal that you see no problem with it. The markings drive away your customers. It also contributes to an increase in violence in the area. Rival gang members cross out the graffiti and soon they begin to fight each other. The community needs to get rid of graffiti and report any offenders. Remember you can remain anonymous when you call our dispatchers. All we need is good information to catch the criminals.

Fight back against prostitution by calling the Police. Prostitutes can be seen strolling repeatedly in an area contacting occupants of vehicles or people on foot. They usually wear revealing clothing that is not appropriate for the cold weather. If you see this type of activity please call our dispatchers at 758-7321. You can remain anonymous but please provide a good description of what you see. You can also contact our Vice Unit at 758-7136.
