## SDU Highlights

A recent robbery teaches that it is important to report even the “little crimes.” Some businesses do not report petty thefts including beer skips. In the case listed below the business did report the beer skip and also had surveillance of that crime. The same criminals returned later in the day and committed a violent robbery at the same business. The video from both crimes provided very strong evidence and led to an arrest. Invest in a good surveillance system and report all crimes that occur at your business. Even the little crimes can lead to the big time cases.

Businesses need to remain vigilant for criminals using counterfeit currency. This month alone we had four reported cases of counterfeit bills. You should train all of your employees to consistently check the bills that they accept. ## Robbery

This category includes robberies to businesses and to individuals on the property of a business.

### Armed / Person

Two suspects, one armed with a firearm, entered the business and demanded that an employee give them the money from the register. The employee was very nervous and fumbled with the keys. The armed suspect struck the employee in the face and told the employee to hurry up. The second suspect came around the counter and took cash from the register.

The suspects did not take much because the business has a policy to keep very little cash in the register. The employee was certain that the two suspects had stolen beer from the business earlier in the day. Another robbery with similar suspects occurred while this case was being investigated. Officers followed some leads and eventually arrested one suspect and found evidence linking him and another male to both robberies and the beer theft.
